Notice of Peter Eelkema's Adoption of Pre-filed Direct Testimony  
of G. Michael Rife on Rocky Mountain Power's Load Forecast

On December 17, 2007, G. Michael Rife filed direct testimony in this case on Rocky Mountain Power's (the "Company") load forecast. Because Mr. Rife is no longer employed with the Company, Mr. Rife's testimony in this case will be adopted and sponsored by Mr. Peter Eelkema.

The Company employed Mr. Eelkema as its Sr. Planning and Financial Analysis Consultant on load forecasting. The Company has employed Mr. Eelkema in its load forecasting area since January 2004. Between 1996 and 2004, Mr. Eelkema was employed first as a staff economist and later as a senior economist for Sierra Pacific Power, focusing on load forecasting. Prior to that time, Mr. Eelkema worked as an economist for the Nevada Attorney General's Office of Advocate for Customers of Public Utilities from 1993 to 1996 and as an economist for the Kansas State Corporation Commission from 1989 to 1993.

Mr. Eelkema has a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Kansas.
