**“SUMMER ELECTRIC RATES HELP YOU MANAGE YOUR ENERGY USE.”**

From May 1 – September 30, the first 400-kilowatt hours (kwh) used per month will be billed at 7.5 cents per kwh. The next 600 kwh will be about 8.9 cents per kwh, and any additional kwh over 1,000 will be about 11 cents per kwh. So the less you use, the less you'll pay. It's wattsmart.
