The Bear River Association of Governments contributed over \$5,000.00 to low income residents in Cache, Rich and Box Elder Counties in 2007 and 2008 through the low income heat assistance program. Will these low income families have to repay their share of the "transponder Questar Underbilling"? There were 2478 families who received this heat assistance in 2008 and about the same number in 2007. How will Questar rebill these people? If Questar had audited the transponder situation quarterly starting in 2006 when they were installed this error would have been discovered. This is TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION. Afterall, audits are required by Sarbannes-Oxley laws.

Questar's earnings were 50% more than last quarter's and they are asking low income customers to pay for their bad management. This is ABSURD!! Please enter this information in the Questar Transponder Hearing on August 19, 2008.
