Pursuant to Utah Code § 63-46b-12, an aggrieved party may file, within 30 days after the date of this Report and Order, a written request for rehearing or reconsideration by the Commission.

I use natural gas in my vehicle. I prefer natural gas vehicles because of the clean energy to efficiency ratio and because it is mostly domestic.  
I already pay more for equipment and service of my vehicle.  
I care about helping clean up the air along the Wasatch Front.  
I care about reducing our dependence on imported oil.
