RE: DOCKET NO. 07-057-13; In the Matter of the Application of Questar Gas Company to Increase Distribution Non-Gas Rates and Changes to Make Tariff Modifications. Filed by the Commission on Monday, December 22, 2008.

Pursuant to Utah Code #63-46b-12, I hereby file a written request for rehearing or reconsideration by the Commission.

I am an aggrieved party. Along with purchasing natural gas to heat my home, I purchase natural gas to run my Honda Civic GX from Questar. I have no alternative for either requirement. Yet I will become one of the highest rate payers for my NGV requirement.

Your decision as stated in this docket is flawed on three counts:

1. Docket 08-057-21 which is still open is seeking public comment on this topic. The jury has decided the case before all of the facts have been presented.
2. The Wexpro resource is being taken out of the equation. These fields have produced natural gas at a vary stable cost of production for many years. They are the basis for a rate structure that is one of the lowest in the nation. The overwhelming majority of Utah NGV users are also Questar customers for home use. These gas fields have been maintained by me and other Questar customers for years. With current and future gas recovering technologies, they will produce for years to come. They should be included in any rate consideration.
3. The docket decision does not specifically require Questar to use the increased tariff to enhance the infrastructure for NGV fuel delivery. If it is not specifically written, do not specifically expect it.

I request a rehearing.

Kindly provide me with at least 7 days notice of when this is to occur.
