Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Utah Code 63-46b-12, an aggrieved party may file, within 30 days after the date of this Report and Order, a written request for rehearing or reconsideration by the Commission.

I am an aggrieved party. I am a Questar customer who uses Questar gas to heat my home, dry my laundry, heat my water, and cook my food. I also happen to use Questar gas to fuel my truck. Why should the natural gas that goes into my truck be charged at a much higher rate than the natural gas that goes into my water heater?

A significant portion of the WEXPRO gas comes from Utah wells. As a resident of Utah and customer of Questar, I have paid for part of the development cost of these gas wells both in monetary and non-tangible ways. Many of the wells are on public land that is partially owned by me. Because of my vested interest in the natural gas resources of Utah, I should be entitled to the benefits of the relatively low cost gas produced from these local wells.

Please reconsider your decision to single out natural gas vehicle owners as somehow different from all of the other natural gas users in the state.
