The recent decision to allow the price of natural gas for vehicles to rise hurts me.

I purchased my NGV for two purposes: 1-to be an environmentally more responsible citizen, and 2-to obtain what I understand to be a plentiful and inexpensive source of fuel so my costs for commuting would be reduced.

This decision negates both of those worthy goals for me. I believe it will virtually totally kill the notion of driving a NGV because it already is a nuisance to drive long distances out of our way to get to the very few natural gas stations in Utah. To make us pay equal to or more than what currently is the price for petroleum fuel feels like getting stabbed in the back for doing something that should be socially very praiseworthy - hence encouraged by public policy.
