Pursuant to the Commission's May 2, 2007 Notice of Public Meeting, regarding the above-docketed matter, Rocky Mountain Power ("Rocky Mountain" or the "Company") supports evaluating the Commission's rules of practice and procedures for formal Commission proceedings. The Company looks forward to actively participating in this process. Since R746-100 contains fifteen subparts governing various areas of practice and procedure, the Company is not submitting an exhaustive assessment of the current rules, but rather will highlight some areas that merit discussion in the June 6, 2007 technical conference, and subsequent proceedings, on the issue. Among those areas meriting discussion include the following:

- Intervention
- Standing
- Public Witnesses
- Representation

There are undoubtedly other issues that deserve future discussion as well. Rocky Mountain looks forward to participating with the Commission staff, the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services and other interested parties in crafting possible amendments to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and in assisting to prepare the rules.
