Dear Commissioners:

The Qwest communications company has sent a letter to me that says you have ordered a new 385 area code to be over-layed on top of the present 801 area code's region. This will require everyone in the 801 region to dial ten digits for local telephone calls instead of being able to just dial seven digits as we can now.

I would rather change my telephone number to 385 than have to dial ten digits every time I make a local telephone call.

Please just divide the 801 region and assign 385 as the new area code to one of the new regions like was done when the 435 area was added. As callers, we will know where the 385 and 801 regions are and can continue to dial just seven digits when we make a telephone call.
