Explanation of terms:

Customer Service Charge: A fee charged that helps pay for the costs of providing service.

Kilowatt-hour (kWh): A measure of electrical energy equal to the amount of energy used by a 100-watt light bulb for ten hours or one 1,000 watt hair dryer for one hour.

Power (kW): The average kilowatts (kW) supplied during the 15-minute period of maximum use during the month as determined by a power meter.

Delivery Voltage: Secondary delivery voltage is service at less than 2,300 volts. Primary delivery voltage is service at 2,300 to less than 46,000 volts where customer provides and maintains all transformers and other necessary equipment. Transmission delivery voltage is service at 46,000 volts or greater through a single point of delivery.

* Holidays: New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Pioneer Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Holidays falling on weekends will be considered holidays on Friday (if a Saturday holiday) or Monday (if a Sunday holiday).

Due to the expansion of Daylight Saving Time the on-peak time periods will begin and end one hour later for the period between the second Sunday in March and the first Sunday in April, and for the period between the last Sunday in October and the first Sunday in November.

All customers are subject to additional charges/credits as set forth in Rocky Mountain Power's retail tariffs approved by the Utah Public Service Commission including Adjustment Schedules 91 and 193.

Rates are in effect August 2007 and are subject to change by commission order.
